Fabian Matz, born 1986 in Basel, Switzerland. Lives and works in the region of Basel. From 2006 to 2010, he completed an apprenticeship as a desktop publisher with a vocational diploma in design at Allgemeine Gewerbeschule Basel and Schule für Gestaltung Basel. From 2013 to 2016 he studied Art & Education at Lucerne University of Applied Sciences and Arts. Since 2016, he has been running his studio "atelier fabian matz - studio for elastic states" and creates as a sculptor and installation artist abstract and sometimes bizarre works in various media and techniques with polyamide tights. In doing so, he makes use of his large collection of different brands, qualities and yarn thicknesses and explores their physical limits and aesthetics. His works have been shown in solo and group exhibitions in Switzerland, the Netherlands, Germany, Ukraine and the USA. Likewise, his work has been presented in nationally and internationally virtually curated exhibitions and publications.











night shift2022, polyamide stockings, epoxy resin, changeant velour fabric on polystyrene hard foam and wood 135×90,5×16,5 cm

Two rectangular shapes were cut from polyamide socks with hardened epoxy resin and each mounted on a handmade wooden object frame. The result is a series entitled "single-part" that can be viewed in pairs or as individual works.





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



shaped bodies (sand)

The Kniepsand on the North Sea island of Amrum looks like an infinite sandpit, inviting you in to play with its fine sand. This location tempted me to play with the sand, too: a strange game. Thanks to the abundant sand, a site-specific, temporary work arose in this infinite, almost unpopulated landscape. My artistic and material engagement with tights is focused on transforming these industrial products into abstract bodies and exoskeletons. Through this playful work, I sought to discover, visually and haptically, how the shape of the polyamide tights altered and how the fabric behaved as it stretched.

The colours and shapes of the fabric created formal connections with the landscape. Driven by the wind, the sand clung to the bodies and made visible the structural changes that the surface of the sand was undergoing on both sides.
